Please note: The SSFOA is a Veterans Administration Volunteer Services Advisory Board Member. As such we are tasked with providing services to V.A. facilities. These services could be time, material or financial. Below were provided in 2009-2008 and 2007. VAVS Number: SSFA 412 (attached are a sampling of letters received from the Veterans Administration documenting services provided for the past three years. Also attached is a sampling of thank you letters for the Homeless Stand Downs we have supported.)

Every Christmas we provide Christmas boxes to at least one V.A. Medical facility in every state.

In July of 2008, we passed the 1 million dollar mark of donations in time and material to the Veterans Administration and to the wounded, ill and dying of our armed forces.

The SSFOA also provides Silver Star Service Banners and Certificates to the wounded and ill of our armed forces from all wars. We have freely given thousands of Service Banners to Alumni from all 50 states.

We also sponsor Silver Star Service Banner Day every May 1st. In 2009 49 states, over 2400 cities and counties, Guam, Saipan, the Chickasaw Nation and the U.S. Virgin Islands issued proclamations to honor the wounded, ill and dying of our armed forces. The state of Missouri has made the day a law and other states are following.

1847 cities and counties have made the day permanent and most hold ceremonies every year for their wounded, ill and dying veterans.
